## RFI No. 1

**Question 1:** Please confirm if the cost for payment and performance bonds required by MD Anderson should be included in the pricing coefficient multiplier or if this cost will be added to the cost of work as a separate line.

**Answer 1:** The costs for payment and performance bonds, when required for specific job orders, are not intended to be covered by the coefficient multiplier. Instead, bond costs may be added as pre-priced or non-pre-priced line items if required.
