

5-PROJECT OVERVIEW

Project Description

- Project is located at the corner of Holcombe Blvd. and South Braeswood Boulevard.
- The Rotary House is a full service hotel that has served thousands of patients and caregivers who come to MD Anderson's Texas Medical Center location each year for cancer treatments.
- The hotel provides lodging, retail, and amenities to include food services, pool, conference center, gift shop, and a fitness area.
- There are currently 322 existing guestrooms.
- The current Request for Qualifications seeks AE services to expand the Rotary House International Hotel to include a new sky bridge connecting the hotel and Braeswood garage.

Project Scope

- The project will include;
 - A hotel tower addition of approximately 182 guest rooms and suites.
 - Additional support space such as;
 - Restaurant/kitchen
 - Laundry Facilities
 - Conference/Meeting Rooms
 - Food and Beverage/Retail Space
 - Utility Infrastructure
 - Service Dock



Project Description

- The project scope is to include the renovation and expansion of portions of the existing facility to improve the functionality of the hotel such as;
 - Possible relocation of the front desk
 - Expansion of the Kitchen and dining areas.
- The new hotel addition is to be designed to a Marriott Premium level standard.
- The scope will also include the design of a pedestrian sky bridge to connect the hotel to the adjacent parking garage.

Project Scope

- A Preliminary Pre-Design Report has been included with the RFQ.
- The selected AE team is to validate the preliminary program (Preliminary Pre-Design Report) and finalize with a complete facilities program meeting the requirements of the UT MD Anderson stakeholders prior to moving into Schematic Design.
- The existing hotel will remain in operation throughout the project potentially requiring phased construction.

- •Construction Cost Limit: \$50,000,000.
- Total Project Cost: \$62,500,000
